

## PDSC/CHYF CYRC Sun 17<sup>th</sup> April 2016



### Introduction

Welcome to Port Dinorwic Sailing Club - Clwb Hwyllo Y Felinheli and Round 1 of the Club Youth Racing Circuit 2016. We are very much looking forward to hosting the event again and seeing you all. If you haven't visited us before this is what you need to know.

### Directions

Once in the village of Y Felinheli turn down the road by the Post Office (about half way through the village on the right if you are coming from Bangor). Follow the road round to the left at the bottom of the hill by the Gardd Fôn pub. Keep going past the playground on your right and you will see the club and dinghy park. There is a large car park just past the club but please park sensibly to allow everyone access.

### Arrivals

Safety boats and competitors' boats can be delivered on Saturday between 2pm and 5pm. The club will be open as club racing will be going on then. If you arrive in time you could join in the racing!!

### Timings & SI's

**Entry Fees:** Single hander £10 Double hander £15

The club will be open at 8:00am on Sun morning. Event timings will be CYRC standard as per the SI's. Please note that the PDSC courses will vary from the standard CYRC courses in order to minimise tidal effect on the races. Registration will open at 9:00. Coaches briefing at 9:30 and RO Safety briefing will be at 10:00 for a first race warning signal at 10:55.

### Galley & Facilities

Our galley team will be opening from 08:30 for hot drinks and snacks and will be serving hot food all day. Please order lunch in advance to avoid disappointment.

The club has WiFi – the log-in code is above the galley. No Charge.

There is a playground and football pitch next to the club and a lovely cycle track to Caernarfon close by for those not sailing.

### The Environment

The club is situated on the Menai Straits. It is very tidal so you need to remember to keep close to the banks going against the tide and out in the middle going with the tide... but make allowances for the tide when judging your lay-lines. High Water on 17<sup>th</sup> April is about 7:45 and so the tide will be going out (towards Caernarfon) in the morning and will be turning after lunch.
